STATE CHAPTERS' REPORT

As we are aware that, in view of Covid-19 pandemic; all National & State chapter conferences/ CMEs were postponed/ cancelled. Few chapters used online platforms to conduct conferences/CMEs/ academic activities:

- 1. Andhra Pradesh Chapter: Conducted 4 online scientific sessions in this last quarter of 2020. First one is on Cutaneous melanocytic lesions by Dr.T. Santosh of AIIIMS, Mangalagiri. 2nd and 3rd were; Role of publications in PG teaching, and What next after M.D (Pathology): Career guidance and opportunities, by Dr.Upendra Srinivas from Visakhapatnam and 4th topic was Rational use of blood and components by Dr.Asitava Debroy of Kishanganj. All sessions were uploaded in youtube page of IAPM AP Chapter.
- 2. Karnataka Chapter: The 47thstate conference "KAPCON 2020" was conducted from 2nd to 4th October 2020. It was virtual event. The conference was organized under the chairmanship of Hon. President KCIAPM Dr.Usha Kini and Hon. Secretary Dr.Vijay Shankar S and Dr. Aditya Agnihotri as Organizing Secretary. The conference had 1354 registered delegates from all states of country with 12 International Registrations. The conference had 40 Faculty of National and International repute who participated in 15 different sessions on various sub-specialities. Three Panel discussions on relevant topics were also held. including one Immunohistochemistry was Moderated by Dr.

Parinitha S S.. 213 papers were presented virtually by the delegates along with 300 posters which were uploaded to the website.

3. Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry chapter:



Virtual Interesting slide seminar was conducted on Oct 17 2020, in which 17 cases were discussed & attended by 150 delegates. An Online CME from November 16th to 21st, 2020, was conducted by MGMCRI, Pondicherry, on Zoom platform under the auspices of TNPC-IAPM. Delegates were welcomed by Dr. S. Sowmya, Lectures included; Dr. Shruti Mishra of BHU on "Rendezvous with HPLC". Dr. Siddaraju. N of JIPMER, on "Cytomorphologic approach to hematolymphoid neoplasms.. Approach to Lichenoid dermatitis by Dr. Sasi Kiran Attilli from Vishakapattinam. Dr. Shubhangi V Agale from Mumbai on Histiocytic disorders of Bone marrow. Dr. Ravichandran, from Chennai and Dr. Marie Therese Manipadam from Vellore discussed "An approach to a child with Leukemia" and "Approach to intra-ductal proliferations of breast" respectively. Dr. Ravichandran discussed necessity of clinico-pathological synergy in childhood leukemia diagnosis & management. Dr. Marie Therese Manipadam discussed the intra-ductal proliferations of breast, Dr. Elanthenral from Vellore and Dr. S. Sowmya, Dr. Elanthendral explained the

approach to lymphoma and interpretation of synovial biopsies. Pathology of Bladder tumors by Dr Santhosh Menon, from TMH, Mumbai and "Interpretation of small bowel pathologies and Malabsorption" by Dr.Prasenjit Das from AIIMS, New Delhi. Nearly 293 delegates attended the session. Total 43 postgraduate students presented e-posters. Vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. K.R. Umadevi. In virtual slide seminar on 28th Nov'2020 interesting cases were presented by faculty and postgraduates. A guest lecture cum virtual slide seminar on "renal tumors" by Dr.Karthik Kalyanasundaram from North Midlands on12th Dec'2020 which was attended by 120 delegates.

4. Uttar Pradesh Chapter: An "Online 2020 Path CME on Bone & soft tissue tumors" was conducted on 25th& 26th Dec'20 by Department of Pathology, Sarojini Naidu Medical College, Agra. The invited speakers were Dr. Bharat Rekhi, Professor, Pathology from Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai and Dr. Pradyumn Singh, Professor, Pathology, Dr. Ram Monohar Lohia Institute of Medical sciences, Lucknow who delivered lecture on 'Role of immunohistochemistry in diagnosis of Soft tissue tumors'& Challenges and pitfalls in histological diagnosis of bone tumors' respectively. CME was inaugurated by Prof. Sanjay Kala, Principal & Dean, S. N. Medical College, Agra and by Prof. S.H. Arif, President, UP Chapter of IAPM. Total 424 delegates from all over India as well as from Nepal were registered. 70 oral papers and 46 e-posters were presented online on 25th & 26th Dec'20 using

Zoom platform with youtube streaming as well. Interesting cases were presented by Dr. Harendra Kumar, Dr. Deepa Rani, Dr. Roopak Agrawal & Dr. Savita Agrawal. The academic sessions were chaired by Prof. Vatsala Misra, Prof. Atul Gupta, Prof. Nuzhat Hussein, Prof. Suresh Babu, Prof. Rani Bansal, Prof. Kalplana Singh, Prof. Mahendra Singh & Prof. Ranjan Agrawal. The organizing team was led by Prof. Rajni Bharti, Organizing chairperson & Dr. Harendra Kumar along with Dr. Pooja Agrawal, Dr. Deepa Rani, Dr. Garima Dundy, Dr. Chandrakanta, Dr. Aprajita Goel, Dr. Taun Mishra, Dr. Prashant Singh, Dr. Pooja Nagayach, Dr. Shikha Prakash & Dr. Neha Azad.

5.
