## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

A few years ago it was stated that 66 to 80 % of cancer affecting man are environmentally induced and thus preventable. Rest 20 to 30 % of cancer are genetically influenced. However, both the factors are required for causation of cancer. When genetic influence is very powerful, minimal environmental effect may be sufficient to precipitate the cause. Of course, these observations are changed to a great extent giving more stress on genetic factors. Much importance is given to the genetic factors in causations and in diagnostic approach for various infectious diseases and malignant tumors. Tissue morphologic basis of diagnosis is corroborated and complemented with molecular biologic techniques. Now pathology is expanding unlimited. Besides morphology, specific immunohistologic and 'molecular biologic studies not only helps in correct diagnosis but also directs effective treatment and predicts prognosis aspect of malignancy.

During past few years in Apcon, there is less stress given in childhood solid tumors. Malignant tumors of childhood differ biologically and histologically from their counterparts occurring later in life. More discussion and research work in this line, definitely will be helpful to correctly diagnose the childhood malignant tumor in early period and the adequate measures in time will be beneficial to prevent disability in the patient. So the theme of Apcon - 2011 is **Fight childhood solid tumors and prevent disability.**

I wish the members to join the annual conference of IAPM to be held at Patiala during the 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> December 2011 and enjoy the Winter Punjab among friends and family.

I would earnestly request to ensure that the IAPM has your correct current correspondence address by informing the honorary treasurer, the honorary secretary and the Editor-in-Chief both by e-mail and by post. Your e-mail address and phone details also would be very helpful. I know for sure, many senior members who have moved places have not officially asked us to change their addresses and the news-bulletins are returning back. Unless the member authorizes the change of communication address on his / her own, it can not be effected. I request members not to request for change of addresses over phone, as it is often difficult to record the changes. In our web-site we are trying to keep a tab for registering / recording your change of communication address, which will then be transferred to the members' address pool. This will take some time.

Computers and internet have now become all pervasive in our lives. The communication revolution in our country have taken internet service providers to every nook and corner of this country, cell phone operators are providing USB internet modems by the dozens. I have a thought of going green by uploading the quarterly IAPM news bulletins in our web-site and so as the conference organizers putting the conference brochures in the conference web-sites, which is also now an international norm. In the process, we save hundreds of trees being cut and saving precious financial resources in terms of postage cost. However, I am sympathetic to our senior members, who would like to receive hard copies and I would put forward a proposal in this year's GBM to deliberate on sending hard copies to only our senior 60+ members.

Our web-site have become quite archaic. I have plans to revamp it in the way that you will have streaming highlights / headlines in the home-page, the home-page is more brighter and colorful, it will have tabs for registering / recording change of addresses, will have links for professionals as well as for public on matters pertaining to diagnostic medicine, will have links to our online-journal, will have links to other pathology international journals, will have a corporate link where corporates will put their product profile at a cost. There will be more updation frequency of the web-site by the web-administrator / web-manager. Finally I propose to make the IAPM election process through online-voting from next year ( 2012 ) after due approval in this year's GBM at Patiala. On-line voting will do away with the constant bickering of members not receiving ballot papers in time through post, exercised ballot not reaching the honorary secretary and hence not being able to exercise their democratic rights.

The conference registration has more or less become on-line. However, many would still like to send it by post. From the database of this years conference, we will try to update the IAPM Members data-base by taking the registered members correct communication addresses. Regarding submission of papers to be read at the 60<sup>th</sup> APCON-2011 Conference, kindly stick to the deadline ( 30<sup>th</sup> September,2011) and under no circumstances it is going to be extended. Depending on the number of papers received and their importance and quality some of the oral papers may be converted to poster presentations at the discretion of the IAPM secretariate / Conference organizers.

The organizing committee of the 60<sup>th</sup> APCON-2011 conference under the dynamic chairmanship of Prof MS Bal is working overtime to make the conference a memorable academic as well as social experience for you. After years the conference is being hosted within the environs of a medical college and I am sure that will add additional academic fervor to this conference. Without any apprehensions in your mind, please keep it in your schedule to attend this yearly event in large numbers. The early registration date has been extended up to 31<sup>st</sup> August,2011. Many eminent pathologists will moderate and speak in various scientific sessions, orations and CMEs during the conference. Many other senior pathologists will give their expertise by chairing these sessions. The IAPM secretariate and the conference organizers will be sensitive to this and will take great care in involving every senior and eminent member who will be attending this conference. I request senior members to register by 30<sup>th</sup> September,2011.
