

# **OBITUARY**

### DR. V. RAMALINGASWAMI

Vulimiri Ramalingaswami, known as 'Rama' to his colleagues and friends, and a doyen of Pathology, scientific research and medical education. He completed his preliminary education, M.B.B.S. and M.D. from Andhra Pradesh, and was recipient of D.Phil (1951) and D.Sc. (1967) from Oxford

Died on: May 28, 2001

University. He joined All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) as Professor and Head of the Department of Pathology in 1957 and went on to become the Director of the Institute in 1969. In

1979, he took charge of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) as its Director-General, the post he held till 1986. He was Scholar-in Residence, Fogarty International Centre, National Institute of Health, Bethesda, Maryland; Visiting Professor in International Health Policy at the Harvard School of Public Health; and Special Adviser to the Execucitve Director, UNICEF, New York on the issue of Child Survival and Development. He served for a long time as a Special Advisor to the International Development Research Council of Canada.

Dr. Ramalingaswami received many honors during his remarkably distinguished career. Some of the prestigious ones were Fellow of the Royal Society, London; Foreign Associate of the National Academy of Sciences of the United States; Foreign member of the Academy of Medical Sciences, U.S.S.R. President of the Indian National Science Academy, and President of the Indian Association of Pathologists & Microbiologists (1971-72). He was also a honorary Fellow of the American College of Physicians and Chairman of the Global Advisory Committee of Medical Research, World Health Organization, Geneva. He was awarded Honorary Doctorate of Medicine by the Karolinska Institute, Stockholm. He was recipient of Padma Bhushan and Padma Vibhushan, the civil honors from Government of India.

Dr. Ramalingaswami had a wide range of research interests. His main contributions were in areas of protein-energy malnutrition, nutritional anemia, liver disease, and disorders arising from nutritional deficiency of iodine. His pioneering study in Kangra Valley is a landmark that paved way for starting an iodine prophylactic programme in India.

He was a fine scientist, a visionary, an inspiring speaker with a marvelous command of the English language; "a gentleman" in the very best sense of that world. Rama had remarkable personal qualities. Colleagues looked up to him for guidance, but also found in him a warmth and friendship that was sustaining.

We own Rama a great debt. He is surely missed.
