Joint Secretary's Report: July- September 2023

Tamil Nadu and Puducherry Chapter:

The Annual conference of the Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry Chapter of IAPM(TNPCIAPM), TAPCON 2023 was hosted by the Department of Pathology, Christian Medical College, Vellore on the 21st and 22nd of July 2023 at Scudder Auditorium, Vellore. This event was preceded by 4 half-day workshops on the 20th of July on FISH, PCR, Coagulation and Transplant Immunology.

The conference topics included Haematopathology, Uropathology, Nephropathology, Clinical Pathology and Transfusion Medicine. National and international experts in the field delivered talks and presented cases. One of the highlights of the conference was a very interesting session comprising a potpourri of cases presented by faciltes from various institutions in Tamil Nadu. An interesting quiz competition was organized.

The conference was well attended by both students and faculty members. A large number of posters were also presented.



Kerala Chapter:

Activities done by IAPM, Kerala in the last 2 months. We have conducted two day (26th and 27th of July2023.) Webinar on "Pathology of Lung, Pleura, Mediastinum". Six sessions were held. 300 plus delegates participated directly in the zoom and another 400 in you tube live. A press conference for urgently implementing Clinical establishment bill without dilution was also organized.



Maharashtra Chapter:

Mid Term CME of Maharashtra Chapter of Indian Association of Pathologist & Microbiologist (MC-IAPM) was organised by the department of Pathology AIIMS, Nagpur and Vidarbha Association of Pathologist and Microbiologist on 8th & 9th July 2023 at AIIMS, Nagpur. The mini-conference was on "Core" issues in Pathology and was attended by 180 delegates.

Dr.Tanuja Shet and Dr. Trupti Pai, Dr. Nalini Bansal, Dr. Rajan Duggal, Dr. Jasmita Das and Dr. Neeraj Arora enlightened the delegates on issue related to core biopsies of breast, lung, liver, prostate, bone marrow and molecular techniques. The highlight of the conference was interactive slide viewing sessions and case-based problem-solving presentations. A total number of 74 papers were presented. This academic feast was inaugurated by Dr. Hanumantha Rao, Executive Director & CEO AIIMS, Nagpur, Dr. Shubhangi Agale Chairperson MC-IAPM, Dr.Mrunal Phatak, Dean Academics, Dr. Prashant Joshi, Office on Special Duty, Dr. Manish Shrigiriwar, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Rasika Gadkari Chairperson, Organising Committee and Dr. Shehnazz Chimthanwala President VAPM.

Andhra Pradesh Chapter

The 5th Annual IAPM Conference of AP Chapter was meticulously organised by department of Pathology, NRI Medical College, Chinakakani, Guntur, under the leadership of Dr. I.V. Renuka. Dr. Janardan Mohanty was born on 21st June 1943 in Balasore. He did MBBS from VSS Medical College, Burla in 1967, internship in SCB Medical College, Cuttack in 1968 and MD Pathology in 1975 from Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi. Immediately after that he joined as Junior teacher in SCB Medical College, Cuttack in 1976 and worked in all the three Govt. Medical Colleges of Odisha in various capacities till 1999. Finally he joined AHRCC and became as Professor & HOD, Oncopathology, AHRCC, Cuttack (now known as AHPGIC) and retired in June, 2001.

As a teacher and professional, he was very popular and efficient and was liked by all. He also had tremendous organisational capacity and throughout his life had organised many conferences, CME and had worked efficiently for our association both at national and state levels. He was Chairman of Pathology Association of Odisha for several years and organised the 1st State Pathology Conference at Burla in 1982. He remained Joint Secretary, IAPM HQ for six years from 1986-1992 and did many developmental works in HQ including building construction and fund raising. He became Vice-President of IAPM in 2002. He was a brilliant academician and was a guest speaker in several conferences, slide seminars, conducted symposia and has received many awards for his contribution including some from AHRCC also. He was recipient of the prestigious SJ Laxman

Pattanaik Memorial award as an eminent doctor. Prof. Mohanty was a well-known figure in IAPM and was liked by many members. As the member of HQ Advisory committee, he attended HQ CMEs and advisory committee meetings regularly and was sincerely giving his inputs for the development.

He is lived by his wife who is also a pathologist and two daughters. One is a gynaecologist and his son-in-law is Professor in Orthopedics in a Government Medical College of Odisha; his second daughter and son-in-law both are engineers. His death has spread a sad wave among his near and dear ones and is mourned heavily. Praying Lord Jagannath to give enough strength to his family members to bear the irreparable loss. Prof. Ashutosh Kumar, Ex. Professor & Head Department of Pathology, K.G.M.U., Lucknow left for heavenly abode on 27th August, 2023. He was born on 29th September, 1954. After completing his MBBS from KGMU, Lucknow in 1976, he did MD (Pathology & Bacteriology), KGMU, from Lucknow in 1979.

Dr. Ashutosh joined as Assistant Professor at M.L.N. Medical College, Allahabad on 23rd March, 1982 and stayed there till 25th March, 1983. He joined as Assistant Professor K.G.M.C. Lucknow on 26th March, 1983 till 08th September, 1988 subsequently to become Associate Professor on 9th September, 1988 to 16th April, 1997 and later became Professor on 16th April, 1997 and Professor & Head from July 2014 to 28th September, 2019. He was Dean of Paramedical Sciences from 2014 to 2016 and later Dean, Faculty of Medicine from 2016 to 2018. After his superannuation Dr. Ashutosh joined as Professor & Head, Deptt of Pathology, Era Medical University, Lucknow.

He worked as In-Charge and Director of State-of-Art Blood Bank at KG Medical University from 2007 to 2009 and it was his vision, planning and execution of plans for the modernization and up-gradation of transfusion services leading to the creation of Department of Transfusion Medicine. Dr Ashutosh Kumar visited Sheffield, United Kingdom as a fellow of Haemophilia Society.

Prof Ashutosh Kumar was a doyen in the field of haematology with a special interest in anemia, leukemia and lymphoma, haemorrhagic and coagulation disorders, and Hemato-oncology, bone marrow aspiration & trephine and, stem cell research. He established haemorrhagic &

coagulation lab with self-preparing reagents and was actively involved in the Haemophilia Society and its social outreach programmes. He was also actively involved in various anemia surveys and organised many camps. He conducted many Conferences and CMEs in the department of Pathology at KGMU, Lucknow.

Prof Ashutosh Kumar Sir was a very simple, humble, down to earth noble teacher who taught his students with all the disciplines of haematology ranging from basics to molecular. Poorest of the poor patients were his top most priority and he used to spend extra hours to get their reports done at the earliest. He was even available to all patients, clinicians, disciples 24x7 on telephone and helped many leukemic cases undergo bone marrow transplantation at CMC Vellore and other reputed medical centres across the country.

Prof Ashutosh Kumar Sir's demise has left a void which would never be filled and this absence would be immensely missed.
