PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



The beginning of this century, has seen major changes in the practice of Pathology as a diagnostic specialty of medicine as well as its teaching to the next generation pathologists. It was not long ago that the pathologists could just sign out surgical pathology / haematology reports based on routine morphology alone based on his observation astuteness and knowledge, sometimes aided with standard histochemical / cytochemical ("special") stains. Times have enormously changed now. Even though routine histo-cyto-morphology remains the central key in diagnostic pathology, the current generation of patients demand and deserve objectivity and reproducibility of the pathologic diagnosis to be accepted as "final diagnosis".

Ancillary techniques which were earlier believed to be the domain of research centres or referral clinical laboratories only, are now increasingly becoming a part of the work-up of diagnostic algorithm. Immunohistochemistry, cytogenetics, molecular genetics of tumours, immunophenotyping, morphometry etc. are being used more and more in routine diagnostic pathology. These techniques have become almost an absolute requirement for any research publications in a decent peer reviewed scientific journal. In order to get the best results and maintain optimum quality in various sub-specialties of pathology, there is an imperative need for pathologists to develop a positive attitude towards incorporating the basic scientists in our diagnostic labs who can contribute a lot in assay / test set-ups and who anyway would require inputs from pathologists for assay / test interpretation.

Science has grown much beyond morphology and diagnostic physicians need not feel insecure of this experienced breed of highly qualified technologists or feel threatened from their presence. Their presence will lend quality to our laboratories and bring in synergy in establishing newer tests in the laboratories. We need to appreciate their strength and understand our limitations in an open mind. Pathologists and basic biomedical scientists together as a team can bring about the best in clinical diagnostics and improve the quality of research in pathology in our country.

APCON 2018 at Bareilly is on the horizon. The Scientific Program for the Conference is nearly ready. The Scientific Program Committee ably led by Prof Siddhartha Datta Gupta have done a commendable job in putting this program in place. Dr. Sharada Rane and Dr. Ranjan Agarwal are tirelessly working to make this conference a grand scientific and social feast. I would request all our members to attend this conference in large numbers in this northern Indian city. Looking forward to see you all soon. Wishing you and everyone in your family a very Happy Festival month ahead.
